

Carbon Management Policy


Carbon management is becoming of increasing importance at global and local levels. The UK has set legally binding CO₂ reduction targets.

MJ Church shall align its' activities with the Circular Economy Package and the Waste Hierarchy and adopt the most environmental and cost-effective options for reducing emissions in the waste, construction and transport sector. This will lead to GHG emission reductions and reinforce the business's synergies between European climate, energy and waste legislation.

MJ Church shall deliver the following specific objectives during 2017:

- MJ Church shall purchase the most environmentally and cost efficient items of mobile plant and haulage equipment.
- MJ Church shall install intelligent software systems into 75% of its transport fleet to allow carbon emissions to be accurately reported and improved upon.
- MJ Church shall install intelligent software solutions into all items of new mobile plant where feasible to allow carbon emissions to be accurately reported and improved upon.
- MJ Church shall calculate accurate carbon management data for each waste stream that is disposed / recovered out of the business.
- MJ Church shall form a carbon management focus group which will meet twice annually to review and improve upon emissions targets.
